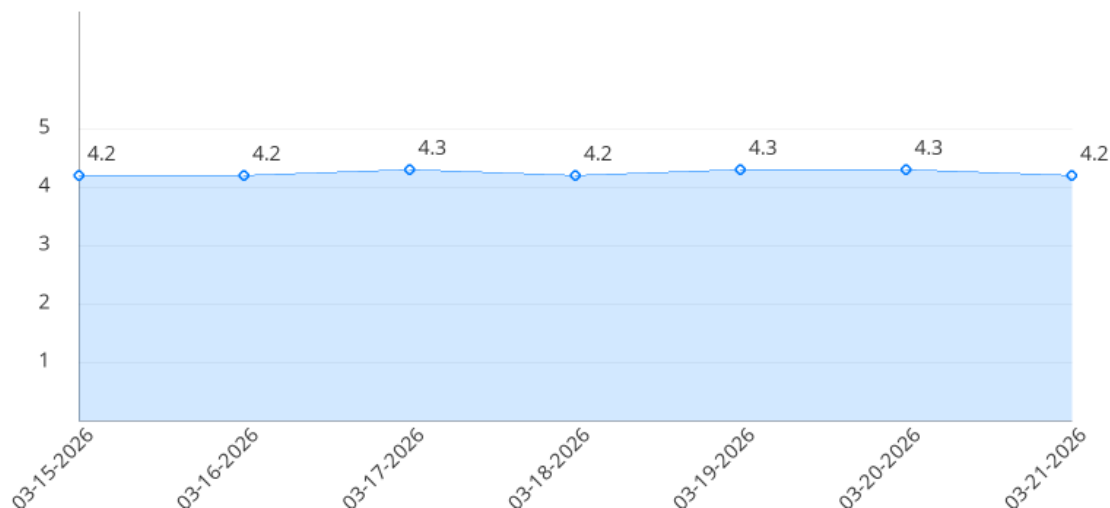

Nuclear War

Score Trend (Week of March 15–21, 2026)



This week, the nuclear threat level remains elevated due to escalating tensions primarily between Iran and Israel, with additional concerns regarding nuclear policy shifts in Europe and NATO's potential nuclear deployments in Finland. The modernization of nuclear arsenals continues to be a significant factor, contributing to strategic instability. Geopolitical tensions in the Middle East, particularly involving Iran, Israel, and the U.S., as well as ongoing risks in South Asia between India and Pakistan, further exacerbate the global nuclear threat. Diplomatic engagement appears to be reduced, heightening the risk of miscalculation and accidental escalation. Overall, the global nuclear threat level is consistently high, with scores ranging from 4.2 to 4.3 throughout the week.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Facilitate urgent diplomatic talks between Iran and Israel to de-escalate tensions and prevent further military actions.
- **[NGO]** Advocate for increased transparency in nuclear arsenals and military activities to build trust and reduce the risk of misunderstandings.
- **[International Organizations]** Reinforce commitment to existing nuclear non-proliferation treaties and seek new agreements to address emerging nuclear threats.
- **[Industry]** Invest in technologies that enhance verification and monitoring of nuclear activities to support international arms control efforts.
- **[Military]** Enhance communication and deconfliction channels between nuclear-armed states to reduce the risk of accidental escalation.

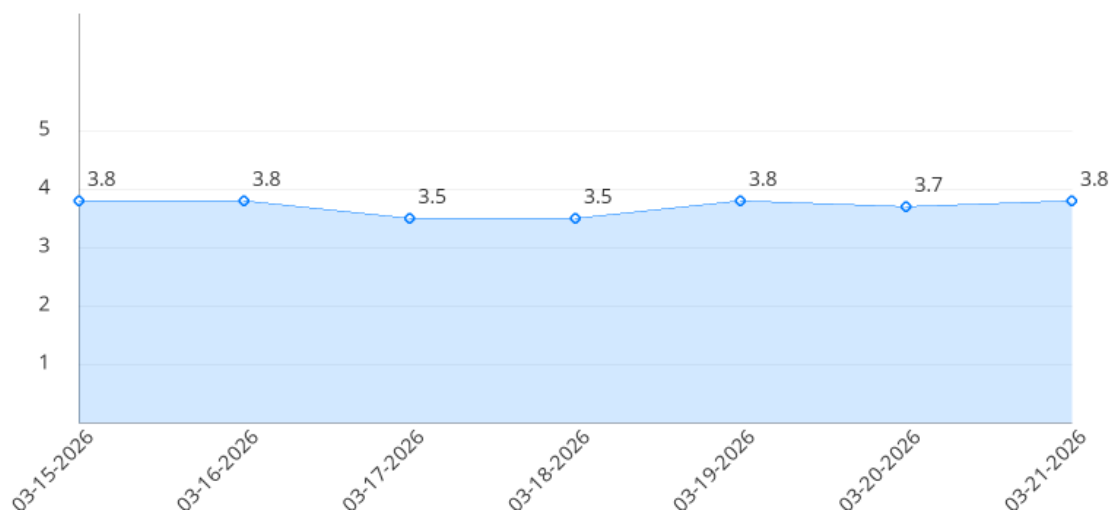

This week, the risk associated with Artificial Intelligence remains moderate, primarily due to continuous advancements in AI capabilities and the formation of strategic partnerships. These developments have raised concerns about the potential for misuse, particularly in military and financial sectors, as well as issues related to AI alignment and safety. The concentration of power and security vulnerabilities are also highlighted as significant risks, with geopolitical tensions exacerbating these concerns. Efforts in AI alignment research are noted, but the need for robust regulatory frameworks and international cooperation is emphasized to manage these risks effectively.

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations on AI deployment in sensitive sectors, such as military and finance, to prevent misuse and ensure ethical use.

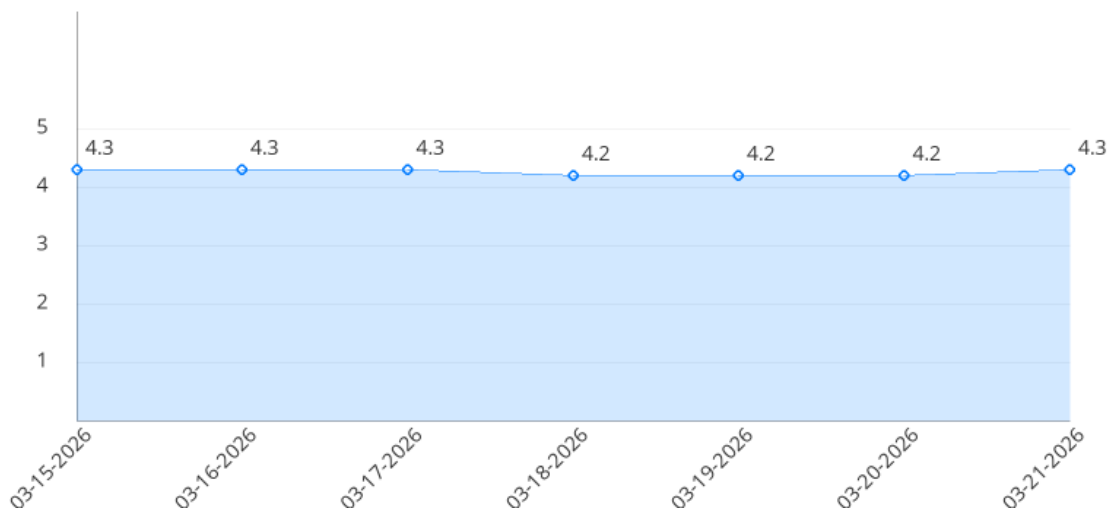

Score Trend (Week of March 15–21, 2026)



This week, the climate change risk level remains high due to several factors, including accelerating global warming, extreme weather events, and significant policy challenges. Critical ecosystems, such as the Himalayas, are destabilizing, and there is a notable retreat of glaciers. These environmental changes are compounded by policy failures and geopolitical tensions, which hinder effective responses to climate threats. 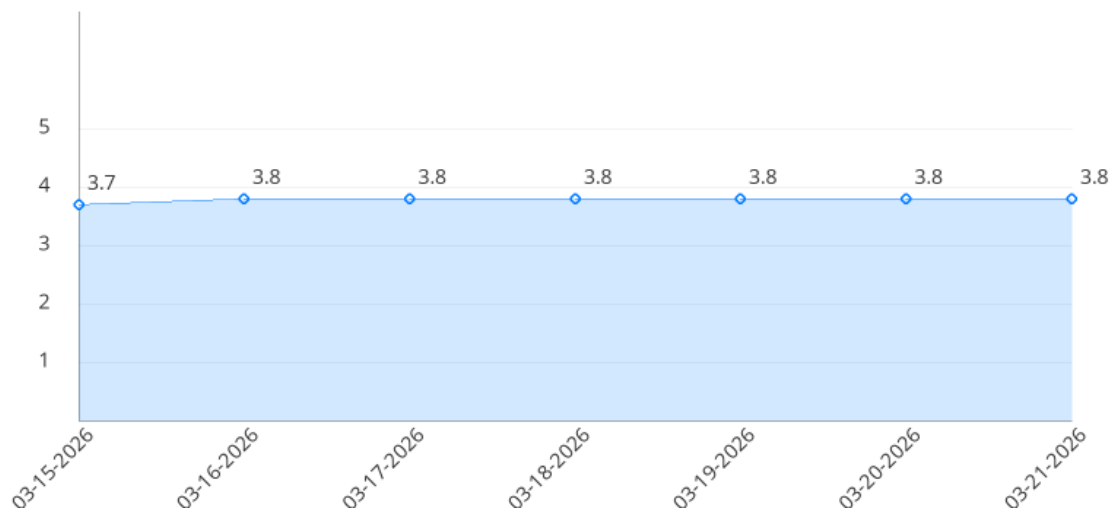

Pandemics

Score Trend (Week of March 15–21, 2026)



This week, the global pandemic risk remains moderate, with a consistent score of 3.8. The risk is driven by ongoing flu and COVID-19 activity, rising avian flu cases, and outbreaks of measles and meningitis, particularly in the UK. Challenges in vaccine deployment and hesitancy, along with misinformation, continue to exacerbate these threats. Surveillance and public health responsiveness are also under strain, impacting the ability to manage these infectious disease threats effectively. The persistence of long COVID among healthcare workers adds to the complexity of the current pandemic landscape.

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Enhance funding and resources for vaccine development and distribution, focusing on emerging pathogens like avian flu and meningitis.
- **[Public Health Organizations]** Strengthen surveillance systems to improve early detection and rapid response to outbreaks, particularly for flu, measles, and meningitis.
- **[NGO]** Launch educational campaigns to address vaccine hesitancy and misinformation, promoting public trust in vaccination programs.
- **[Healthcare Industry]** Accelerate research on long COVID to develop effective treatments and support healthcare workers affected by the condition.
- **[International Organizations]** Facilitate global cooperation in pandemic preparedness, focusing on early detection and rapid containment of infectious disease outbreaks.

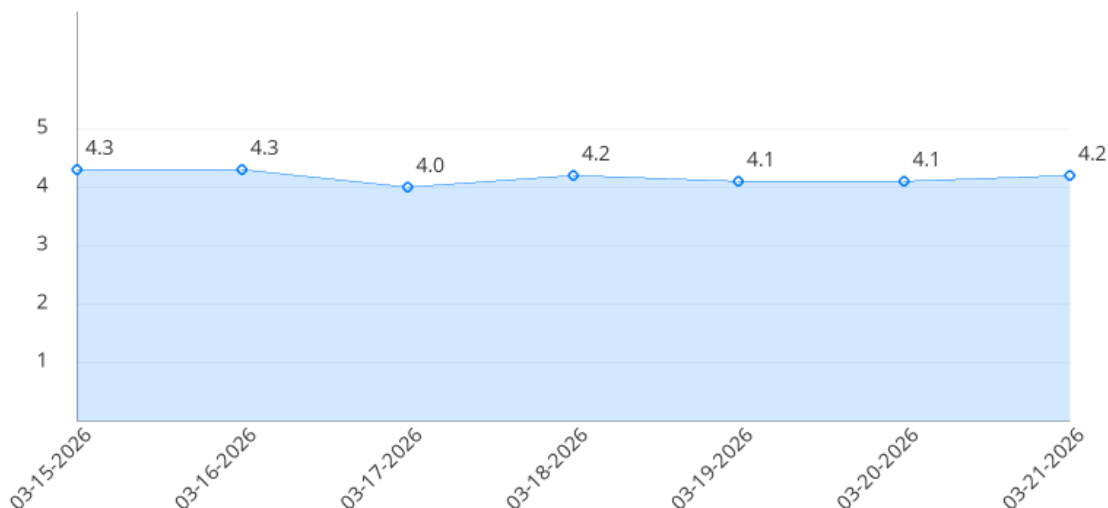

Information Integrity

Score Trend (Week of March 15–21, 2026)



This week, the global misinformation risk remains high, primarily driven by AI-generated content and geopolitical disinformation. The persistence of false claims about geopolitical events, particularly those involving Iran, has exacerbated public confusion. Health misinformation and scams have also contributed to the high risk levels. Despite efforts to address these issues, the proliferation of fake news online continues to challenge information integrity. The scores have consistently indicated a high risk, reflecting the ongoing struggle to manage the impact of misinformation on public opinion and policy.



Information Integrity

Recommended Risk Reduction Actions

- **[Government]** Implement stricter regulations and penalties for the creation and dissemination of AI-generated misinformation, particularly during geopolitical conflicts.
- **[Industry]** Develop and deploy advanced AI tools to detect and flag misleading content in real-time on social media platforms.
- **[NGO]** Launch public awareness campaigns to educate citizens on identifying and countering misinformation, focusing on geopolitical and health-related falsehoods.
- **[International Organizations]** Facilitate cross-border collaborations to address misinformation that affects global peace and security.
- **[Education Sector]** Integrate media literacy programs into curricula to equip individuals with skills to discern misinformation effectively.

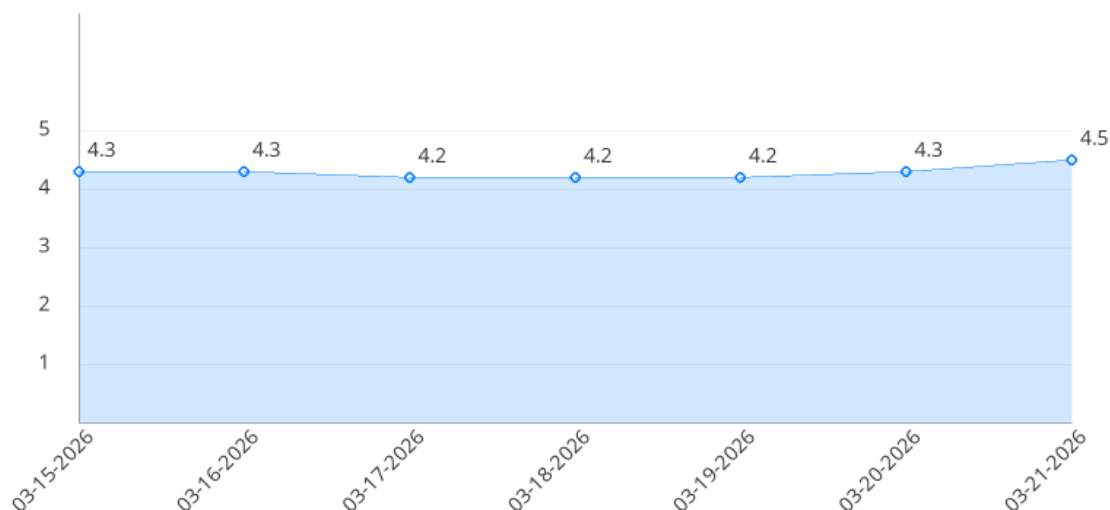

This week, the main trend in existential risks involves two significant Black Swan scenarios: unusually high rates of solar flares and geopolitical instability in the Middle East, particularly involving Iran. Week in Review: March 15–21, 2026

Climate change risks are high, driven by global warming, extreme weather, and policy challenges, impacting ecosystems and food security. Pandemic risks remain moderate, with ongoing flu and COVID-19 activity and challenges in vaccine deployment. Information integrity is under significant threat from AI-generated content and geopolitical disinformation, maintaining a high risk level. Finally, Black Swan scenarios, such as increased solar flares and Middle Eastern geopolitical instability, underscore the interconnected nature of global risks, necessitating robust preparedness strategies.
